Preamble note: All the gymnastics equipment is conform to the FIG rules (GYMNOVA, Official Supplier of 2012 and 2016 Olympic Games).

It's strictly forbidden to remove, change or replace the equipment without the authorization of the Competition Director and the equipment responsible person.

OPEN MASSILIA- Team Competition

FRIDAY 22TH NOVEMBER 2019

9:30AM - 4:00 PM

TEAMS

- 4 gymnasts per team, 13 years old and over (**born in 2006 and before – JUN/SEN**)
- 4 gymnasts will compete on each apparatus.
- The 3 best scores will be taken into account.
- Competition 1 of **the FIG code of points 2017/2020**.
- The teams will be divided on 2 different groups
 - Group A: Team 1 of federations.
 - Group B: Team 2 of federations, clubs or training centers.
- The starting order of teams and the 1st apparatus will be drawn at the Technical Meeting which will take place on **Thursday 21st November, 16.30 at the “Palais des Sports” (meeting room)**.

CONCOURS : C1 FIG SENIOR&Vault (Junior competition): 2 different vaults

QUALIFICATION for the MASTER MASSILIA, Official team competition

- The ranking by team will qualify the 4 best teams for the Official MASTER Competition on Saturday afternoon with maximum 8 teams
- **Maximum 2 teams per nation will be allowed to compete at the MASTER competition.**
“A MIXED TEAM” is not considered as a team of one federation or nation
- The final decision is under the responsibility of the competition Director. The number of qualified teams can be modified according to the number of the participating teams at the Master and to the technical level of the OPEN competition (up to 8 teams maximum registered in the MASTER)

WARM UP

- The Warm up will be organised 2h00 for the round with 10 teams and 1h40 for the round with 8 teams (20 min general warm up + 10 min/team/apparatus) before the beginning of the competition, in **the Training Hall, Salle TEISSEIRE**
- End of the Warm up: 10 minutes before the beginning of the competition (for the official presentation on the competition stage).

COMPETITION

- **According to the rules, each team will have 2 minutes of preparation per team on each apparatus during the competition.**
- The team at “the rest position” must stay on the field of play (FOP) or can go to the training hall (Teissere hall)

- The team starting at “the rest position” can go back to the training hall after the presentation.

JUDGES PANELS:

The judges panel will be composed by judges with a current valid FIG Brevet (2017-2020) and will be supplemented by national Brevet French judges.

They all will be under the responsibility of Marianne ASSADI, judge FIG FRA Level 2.

The Judge Meeting will take place on Friday 22nd November at the “Palais des Sports” in the “Meeting Room” at 8.15 am.

AWARD CEREMONIES:

- The results and the award ceremonies will be held at the end of the OPEN competition on Friday.
- All the teams should wear **the COMPETITION ATTIRE**

* In case of tie, the Olympic rules specified in the F.I.G Technical Regulations will be applied (total points of the team at the 3, 2 and 1 best apparatus).

MASTER MASSILIA - Team Competition

SATURDAY 23TH NOVEMBER 2019
4.30PM - 7.00 PM

TEAMS:

Are invited the teams qualified for the Concours 4 of the World Championships Stuttgart 2019, (GER).

- 4 gymnasts maximum by team.
- 4 gymnasts will compete at each apparatus; the 3 best scores will be taken into account.
- The competition will be according to the rules of the FIG Competition 1, code of points 2017/2020 (VAULT : Junior rule).
- **The 8 teams will be distributed on 4 groups. Each group will be composed by 2 teams.**
- **Maximum 2 teams per nation are allowed to compete at MASTER.**
- The starting **order of the teams and the 1st apparatus will be drawn at the Technical Meeting on Thursday 21th November, at 16.30, "Meeting Room", "Palais des Sports"**

WARM UP:

- The warm up will be organised on the competition podium from 15.00 to 16.20 (10 min/team/apparatus)
- The warm up will be organized according to the starting order of the teams, drawn at the technical meeting. Each team will end the warm up on its first competition apparatus.
- **During the competition, each team will have its statutory time of preparation on each apparatus.**

JUDGES PANELS:

- The judges panel will be composed by judges with a current valid FIG Brevet (2017-2020) OR be by national Brevet French judges.

They all will be under the responsibility of Marianne ASSADI, judge FIG Level 2.

The Judge Meeting will take place on

Saturday 23rd November at the "Palais des Sports" in the "Meeting Room" at 15h15

AWARD CEREMONIES

- The results will be given at the end of the official competition MASTER.
- The ranking by team will select the winning team of the 10th ELITE GYM MASSILIA, the 3rd first teams will be awarded

- All the teams should wear the **COMPETITION ATTIRE**

* In case of TIE, the Olympic rules specified in the F.I.G Technical Regulations will be applied.
(total points of the team at the 3, 2 and 1 best apparatus).

* An individual ranking "General Concourse" will award the 3 best gymnasts of the competition who will have performed at all apparatus.

The GYMNOVA CUP will award the best JUNIOR gymnast of the competition.

QUALIFICATION FOR THE FINALS (TOP MASSILIA)

At the end of the MASTER and the OPEN MASSILIA team competitions, an individual mixed ranking (Junior and Senior gymnasts) will be established at each apparatus

The 8 best gymnasts, maximum 2 gymnasts per FEDERATION, will be qualified for the Finals.

For a better organization, the gymnasts will be divided in 2 groups at each apparatus : group A from the 1st to the 4th qualified gymnast, group B from the 5th to the 8th gymnast.

On Vault, only the gymnasts who can perform 2 different vaults in qualification will be attend the FINAL

AWARDS

- The Prize moneys will be paid by international bank transfer to the Federation.

* In case of TIE, the Olympic rules specified in the F.I.G Technical Regulations will be applied.

GYMNASTS

8 gymnasts Junior/Senior will be qualified at each apparatus on the issue of the team competitions of Friday 22th and Saturday 23th November.

THE COMPETITION

C3 FIG except on VAULT FIG JUNIOR Competition

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

At the end of the MASTER and the OPEN MASSILIA team competitions, an individual ranking Junior and Senior will be established at each apparatus and will qualify the 8 best gymnasts for the finals, maximum 2 gymnasts per federation in each final.

In case of the participation in both competitions, OPEN and MASTER, ONLY the scores obtained at the MASTER competition will be taken in consideration for being qualified for the FINALS.

On **VAULT**, only the gymnasts who will have performed 2 different vaults in qualification will attend the FINAL

STARTING ORDER

For reasons of organization and timing, the 8 gymnasts will be divided into 2 groups at each apparatus: « A » the first 4 gymnasts and « B » the gymnasts classified from 5th to 8th place.

The starting order will be the reverse order of the ranking in qualifications.

The direction of the competition reserves the right to derogate from this rule in case of qualification of the same gymnast to the 2 apparatus of each part of the finals (VAULT and BEAM – UNEVEN BARS and FLOOR)

COMPETITION

- The competition will be on the Competition 3 of the Code of points 2017/2020
- VAULT : CONCOURS 3 FIG JUNIOR
- The finals will be held as follows:

WARM UP:

- The warm up will be on the podium before the competition from 13.45 to 14.45;
- The preparation for the VAULT will be carried out in accordance with the regulations of the competition 3 FIG.

RANKING:

- On each apparatus, the ranking list will define the 3 best gymnasts who will be awarded.
- In case of a tie, the Olympic rules specified in the FIG technical regulations will be applied.
- All the prize moneys will be paid by international bank transfer through the Federations.

JUDGES PANELS:

It will be under the responsibility of Marianne Assadi and will be composed as follows:

- International FIG Judges, with FIG Brevet 2017/2020
- French National judges.
- The Judge Meeting will take place on SUNDAY 24th November at the "Palais des Sports" at the "Meeting Room" from 2.00pm
